1. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

Participants who are eligible to compete in two disciplines may choose to compete in one or both.

Evaluation

5.1. The top 3 finishers in each age group are awarded in the RR and ITT races.

5.2. The following nominations are made in the Health race:

Fastest man (17+) Fastest woman (17+) Fastest youth (17-) Fastest young woman (17-)

6. Registration Registration must be done on the platform offered by the Latvian Cycling Federation: bulta.lv/riga.

Pre-registration is open from April 12 and will close on May 7 at 12:00 p.m. Participants can register on-site at the registration center for Children, Health, Women, and Sports classes starting from 14:30.

7. Participation Fee

7.1. There is no participation fee for children's races.

7.2. Participation fee for Youth groups from U12 - U18: EUR 10.00 for one distance or EUR 15.00 for two distances.

7.3. Participation fee for the Health class: EUR 15.00.

7.4. Participation fee for adults in Road races: EUR 20.00.

7.5. Participation fee for adults in Individual races: EUR 20.00.

7.6. Participation fee for adults in Individual and Group races: EUR 30.00.

The participation fee must be paid after pre-registration. Only participants who have paid the participation fee by transfer, transfer upon invoice, or on-site will be included in the list of participants.
